Seeing as Jane was a specialist in monkeys she travelled to many different countries. On April 2nd, 1957, at the age of 23 - almost 24 - she travelled to Kenya to study and unexpectedly met a famous anthropologist and palaeontologist - Dr Louis Leakey. Dr Leakey was impressed with Goodall's knowledge upon animals.

The Mother of the Naturalist Confirmed that they travelled a lot once animals became a ^{part} of their lives. Dr Leaky said that Jane did not want to leave Africa as it was fun and interesting. Despite the anthropologist she met, the chimps were very loving to her. It was a long journey to Africa as they went by boat.

Back in 1960, the naturalist set out to Tanzania to study wild chimpanzees and learn how they behave. Immersing into primates lives, Jane made discoveries about behaviour of ~~the~~ monkeys. A highly respected member in the Society of Science is Goodall and her research. ~~Following~~ as a result of this, she has had to go to many conventions throughout her life.

Later life

In 1960 Baron Hugo Van Lawick, a dutch wildlife photographer, was sent to Africa by the National Geographic Society to film Goodall at work. Aside from being a photographer, this is how Goodall made money from documentaries. Therefore, Jane was able to go on more ~~researchable~~ ^{interesting} places to study. The assignment ran longer than they anticipated and the couple fell in love. They were married on March 28th 1964 and their European honeymoon marked one of the rare occasions on which Goodall was absent from Gombe Stream. In 1967 Jane gave birth to a son - Hugo Eric Louis - known as 'Grub'. In 1976, Goodall divorced Van Lawick and married Derek Bryceson, a member of Tanzania's parliament and director of its National Parks.
